

South Australian Regional Bridge Upgrades

Reedy Creek and Thornlea, Princes Highway

We are upgrading a series of bridges and culverts across regional South Australia to extend the service life of the structures and improve safety for road users.

What's happening:

Before speed limits can be fully reinstated, final pavement spray sealing, and final line marking are required. Due to weather conditions being unsuitable for the completion of the asphalt works, and other technical constraints, works have been unable to progress until now.

How this affects you:

During work hours there will be changes to traffic conditions to keep everyone safe at both sites. Following completion of the pavement works, reduced speeds will be required at all times until the final line marking is complete. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Slower speeds will be required in the work area until line marking is complete.

If weather conditions are not favourable again these works will be undertaken in January 2024. See the project website and onsite signage for updates.

No works will be undertaken between Friday, 22 December 2023 and Sunday, 7 January 2024.
