Furner Road Junction Remediation Works

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users. The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

What's happening:

Pavement remediation works are required at the junction of Princes Highway and Furner Road near Millicent to ensure ongoing safety for all road users.

When

Thursday 11 July 2024 and Friday 12 July 2024, weather permitting.

Hours of operation

Between 7am and 5pm

Where

Junction of Princes Highway and Furner Road, Millicent

How this affects you:

Traffic will be maintained at all times in both directions on both the Princes Highway and Furner Road.

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place on the Princes Highway and Furner Road.

Speed restrictions will remain in place until all finishing works have been completed. Please plan ahead, be cautious around workers, and follow the direction of on-site signage.

Should works be postponed due to inclement weather, they will be rescheduled to the next available working day.
