CCTV and lighting upgrade

As part of the South Australian government's election commitment, we are improving safety at the West Croydon Railway Station.

What's happening:

The works will include:

- upgrade of existing light poles to combined light and CCTV poles
- electrical installation works, including cabling and trenching
- installation of new emergency help phones
- improved Public Announcement speakers and
- new CCTV installed in the underpass / subway.

How this affects you:

These works will occur during the day and night.

Temporary lighting towers will be used at night along the platform to ensure safe working conditions for the team.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works on Day and Euston Terraces.

Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, we will try to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible.

We will maintain access to properties and make every effort to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road use.
