

John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade

Temporary road closures – Winklebury Road and Haydown Road

We are upgrading the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road in Elizabeth Vale

This upgrade forms part of the State Government's election commitments, to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and to make travel easier for all users.

What's happening

Works are continuing at the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road in Elizabeth Vale.

To safely facilitate the next stage of works additional traffic restrictions, including temporary road closures, are required.

How this affects you

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will remain in place throughout the work area for the duration of the project. In addition, the following traffic restrictions will be in place:

- From 7am Monday, 18 November 2024 to 5pm Wednesday, 20 November 2024 for the full three days, Winklebury Road, at the John Rice Avenue junction, will be closed to all traffic, including outside of work hours.
- Between Sunday, 1 December 2024 and Thursday, 12 December 2024 there will be intermittent closures of Haydown Road, at the John Rice Avenue junction. These temporary closures will be undertaken at night, between 7pm and 6am, as required.

Local detours will be in place during closures. Please follow onsite signage for alternative routes and observe the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

Sunday to Friday between the hours of 7pm and 6am
