

Victor Harbor Road Safety Improvements

Work Notice

The Australian and South Australian governments have committed \$15 million (80:20 basis) for safety upgrades on Victor Harbor Road as part of the \$810 million Fleurieu Connections projects.

These upgrades include the intersection of Hindmarsh Tiers Road and Virgin Road and the junction of Brookman Road.

What's happening

From Monday 3 February 2025, we will setup our site compound at the intersection of Victor Harbor Road and Brookman Road. The initial work will include service location, surveying, tree and vegetation removal and site preparation.

Construction work will begin from mid-February 2025 and involve widening the entrance from Brookman Road into Victor Harbor Road, adding curbs, gutters, drainage, asphaltting, shoulder sealing, installing guard rail, lighting, median islands and line marking.

Some work, including asphaltting and line marking, may take place at night to ensure the safety of workers and road users. We will notify you in advance before any night work begins and will do our best to minimise any impact on nearby properties and road users.

How this affects you

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible.
