Contact generated from DPTI **Way2Go** roll out plan as well as a strategic contexts and circumstances

Council processes information and formally agrees to join **Way2Go**

DPTI consults with relevant council staff to identify the school/s to be approached

Way2Go team member meets school principal (& interested staff, parents) to outline the program.

Principal consults school community

Formal invitation to join **Way2Go** accepted

Way2Go Senior Program Officer, Council and DPTI traffic engineers develop plans to review specific transport issues and built environment improvements at identified school sites
