Darlington Upgrade Project

Drainage Night Works November 2016



As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project works recently commenced adjacent the Main South Road junction with the Southern Expressway to install a major stormwater drainage system.

The drainage system is being installed through a method called 'pipe-jacking' where two large pits are excavated at either side of the Southern Expressway and a pipe is installed beneath the road surface via a horizontal drilling process.

The works commenced in mid October 2016 and are scheduled for completion in late November 2016.

Works are currently occurring from Monday to Friday and will also be undertaken between 6am and 6pm on:

- Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 November 2016
- Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 November 2016
- Saturday 19 and Sunday 20 November 2016

A crane, excavator and vacuum trucks will be on site. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents as much as possible.

No traffic restrictions are required for these works.
