

Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

The Australian and South Australian Governments have announced a reconfigured four way intersection will be constructed at the junctions of Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Roads to improve transport capacity and safety for all road users. The upgrade will also improve connectivity for vulnerable users and support adjoining land use.

Goodwood Road is one of southern Adelaide's major north-south arterial routes, with Springbank Road and Daws Road providing key east-west connection. Approximately 60,000 vehicles travel through the current intersections each day, with delays common during peak periods.

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure will continue to liaise with the community as the preferred design is developed. All feedback and concerns will be considered as the project team continue through the design process to identify a solution that balances the needs of the project's various stakeholders.

Early site investigation works

As part of the early design process, works to identify the location and depth of all utility services in the vicinity of the proposed upgrade will occur throughout October and early November.

These works will be undertaken during the day between the hours of 9am and 4pm and will take approximately four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic at all times. Access for properties, pedestrians and cyclists will also be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users where possible.
