Northern Connector Project

The \$867 million Northern Connector open to traffic

The new six-lane, 15.5 kilometre motorway will officially open to traffic on Saturday, 7 March 2020. The new motorway will provide a vital freight and commuter link between the Northern Expressway, South Road Superway and Port River Expressway.



The opening will be undertaken in stages with the northbound carriageway opened from approximately 9am, followed by the southbound carriageway. It is anticipated that the motorway will be fully open in both directions, including the four interchanges early afternoon Saturday.

The six lane motorway will have a maximum posted speed limit of 80km/h for the first few weeks to enable driver familiarisation, commissioning and completion of testing.

Finishing works will continue over the coming weeks and may require some lane and speed restrictions, and a temporary closure, to ensure the safety of motorists and workers accessing the site. Advance notice will be provided.

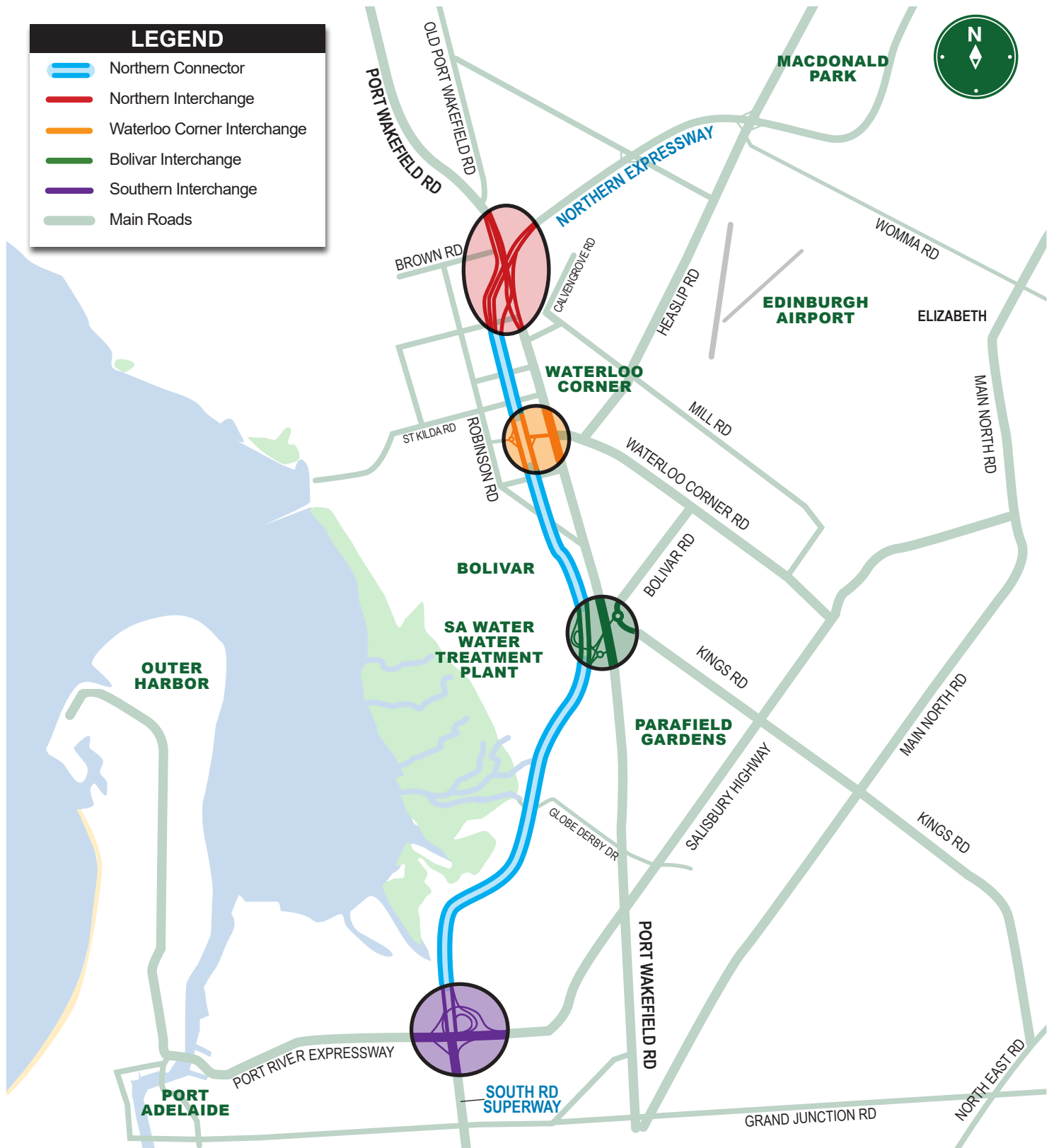
