



# Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Road Intersection Upgrade

## Construction Update

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport is upgrading the intersection of Goodwood, Springbank and Daws Roads to improve travel times, connectivity, capacity and safety for all users. The \$61 million project is jointly funded (50:50) by the Australian and South Australian governments.

Service relocation works, including SA Power Networks 66kV & 11kV infrastructure, SA Water main alterations, APA Gas works, and the relocation of telecommunications infrastructure are nearing completion.

Major construction works for the intersection upgrade commenced in late January 2021, with project completion expected in late 2021, weather permitting.

Pavement construction has commenced on the new sections Springbank Road and Daws Road, as well as the installation of new drainage, earthworks, concrete works, and demolition of the existing medians across the site to facilitate the realigned intersection. Removal of the existing stobie poles and street lighting has also commenced and will be replaced with temporary lighting towers until the new street lighting is installed. Further updates will be provided as the works progress.

### Time of Works

The majority of the works will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 6pm.

Speed restrictions will be in place during the works, and lane restrictions will be implemented intermittently to maintain the safety of road workers.

Night works will be required on several occasions during major construction, and are expected to commence in March 2021. Advance notice of the night works will be provided as works progress.

Please take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access for properties will be maintained throughout the works and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible. Where works will restrict property access, the project team will contact affected property owners.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be a need to restrict some access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.
