

Nairne Intersection Upgrade

Project Update

The Department for Infrastructure and Transport (the Department) has delivered improved safety and traffic efficiency through the construction of a four-way, single lane roundabout to realign the Woodside Road and Saleyard Road junctions with the Old Princes Highway, Nairne.

What's next?

The next stage of work involves landscaping on and around the roundabout. The Department is seeking feedback on the attached landscaping plan. The plant species are a mix of native ground covers, shrubs and medium sized flowering natives. The landscape plan is also available to view on the project website <http://www.dit.sa.gov.au/nairne>

Following community consultation, these works are expected to commence late July 2022, and will be complete in September 2022, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, between 7am and 5pm.

The roundabout will remain open to traffic at all times while landscaping works are undertaken.

The Department is currently reviewing options for the surplus land parcels. More information will be available in the coming months.
