


Section 174A(12) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961*

Approval of the manner and form of a nomination

I, **Anastasios Koutsantonis**, Minister for Infrastructure and Transport in the State of South Australia, hereby **APPROVE** the manner and form detailed in Schedule 1 for a nomination under section 174A(12) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961*.

SCHEDULE 1

1. A nomination for the purposes of section 174A(12) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961* may be submitted to a council or officer specified in the expiation notice, in writing on paper or via electronic means (including but not limited to, entering necessary information into a website managed by a local council in South Australia) and must contain the information in points 2 and 3 below.
2. A nomination for the purposes of section 174A(12) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961* must be attested to by the nominator by signing the nomination and/or verifying their identity in accordance with the instructions of the council.
3. A nomination for the purposes of section 174A(12) of the *Road Traffic Act 1961* must contain the following information:
 - a. the name of the person to whom the expiation notice was issued (the *nominator*);
 - b. the address of the nominator, which may include an email address;
 - c. the Expiation Notice Number or other identifying information as it appears on the notice;
 - d. the registration number of the vehicle involved in the alleged offence;
 - e. if the nominator was not the driver during the time of commission of the alleged offence, the name and address of the person who was responsible for the vehicle at the time of the alleged offence (the *nominee*);
 - f. the capacity in which the nominee was responsible for the vehicle (e.g. whether as driver, owner, lessor, bailee in possession, etc);
 - g. a statement to the effect that the issuing authority may require the nominator to verify the information contained in the nomination by statutory declaration;

- h. a statement to the effect that a nomination that is false or misleading in a material particular is a serious offence and carries heavy penalties under section 174A(13) of the Act.
4. If the person had transferred ownership of the vehicle to another person prior to the time of the alleged offence and has complied with the *Motor Vehicles Act 1959* in respect of the transfer, details of the transfer (including the name and address of the transferee) must be provided.
