

# Princes Highway Corridor Upgrade

## Roundabout upgrades, Mount Gambier

We are upgrading the Princes Highway Corridor, from Meningie to the South Australian/Victorian border, to improve long term safety and efficiency for all road users.

The \$190 million Princes Highway Corridor program is jointly funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian (20%) governments.

### What's happening.

We are upgrading the roundabout at the intersection of Wehl Street North and Jubilee Highway West to improve road quality and safety.

Asphalt pavement works will now be undertaken at the intersection of Wehl Street North and Jubilee Highway West through the roundabout.

### How this affects you

**Access to and from Wehl Street North at the roundabout on Jubilee Highway West will be unavailable from Tuesday 2 April 2024 until Saturday 13 April 2024, weather permitting.** See detour overleaf.

Jubilee Highway West will remain open at all times. During work hours, temporary traffic signals will be in place to control the direction of travel. Traffic controllers will be on site to help manage the flow of traffic around the works and keep road users safe.

Outside of work hours, **access to and from Wehl Street North at the roundabout will remain closed.** Traffic signals will be removed outside of work hours with Jubilee Highway West reopened to one lane in each direction for eastbound and westbound movements through the roundabout only.

**The current detour for heavy vehicles will remain in place via O'Leary Road, Pine Hall Avenue and Riddoch Highway, Mount Gambier.**

Local bus routes will be still operating with minor detours in place around the works.

Pedestrians and cyclists will need to use a different path during the works; signs will show you where to go. During the works, there might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum. You might also notice some odours, which is normal during asphalt work.

## Upcoming Works

Following the completion works at the Wehl Street North roundabout, the next stage of works will commence in mid-April 2024 including:

- Pavement rehabilitation works on Jubilee Highway West between Suttontown and Wehl Street North.
- Upgrading the roundabout at the intersection of Jubilee Highway West and Penola Road (Riddoch Highway).
