

Yorktown Road and Adams Road roundabout

Early Works Notice

We are working to improve safety and reduce waiting times for motorists turning right out of Adams Road onto Yorktown Road. This forms part of the State Government's election commitments to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and make travel easier for all users.

What's happening:

Early works, including service relocation, will be undertaken at the junction in anticipation of major works commencing in mid-2024.

How this affects you:

To do this work, some speed and lane restrictions will be in place as required during work hours, with advance notice to be provided via onsite signage. Some minor vegetation removals will also be required.

We will work to ensure we avoid impacts during peak periods. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress. Outside of working hours, speed and lane restrictions will be removed.

During the works, there may be some noise and dust from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.

We look forward to sharing more information including the final design, and our detailed landscaping plan in the coming months.
