

# Road Safety Program

## Upper Yorke Road, Port Broughton to Bute

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to Upper Yorke Road between Port Broughton to Bute. These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 3 years.

### What's happening:

We are undertaking a number of road safety upgrades on this section of Upper Yorke Road including shoulder sealing, Audio Tactile Line Marking (ATLM), and vegetation management. These upgrades will deliver improvements to freight movements, support regional economic growth and improve safety for all road users.

### How this affects you:

Works will move progressively along Upper Yorke Road as required. To do this work safely we'll have speed and lane restrictions in place in work areas. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs. Outside of work hours speed restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

You will still be able to access businesses and homes. If we need to limit access, we'll let property owners know ahead of time.

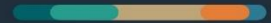
