Road Safety Program

Mannum Road, Mannum to Murray Bridge

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, urban roads, footpaths, and cycle paths around South Australia.

The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) Governments over three years.

What's happening

Works are continuing between Mannum and Murray Bridge. The works will include shoulder sealing, stormwater upgrades and safety barrier installation.

How this affects you

To do this work safely we'll have speed and lane restrictions in place in work areas with temporary traffic signals in place to manage the flow of traffic. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signs at all times. Outside of work hours lane restrictions will be removed, however speed restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

You will still be able to access homes and properties. If we need to limit or impact access, we'll contact property owners ahead of time. If you have any questions regarding access, we encourage you to contact us to discuss.
