

Kangaroo Island Road Safety and Bushfire Resilience Package

Project Update - Recommencement of works

We are delivering an upgrade to Kangaroo Island's key arterial roads to improve road safety and bushfire resilience. This \$40 million package of upgrades is funded by the Australian (80%) and South Australian government (20%).

What's happening:

Works including pavement construction and sealing, line marking, audio tactile line marking and safety barrier installation are recommencing on Hog Bay Road and Playford Highway.

How this affects you:

To keep everyone safe there will be changes to traffic conditions for the duration of works.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of works on Hog Bay Road and the Playford Highway. Speed restrictions will remain in place until all works are completed in December 2024, weather permitting.

We appreciate that works across Kangaroo Island have been ongoing for an extended period of time. We would like to thank you for your patience and understanding while these critical upgrade works are undertaken.
