Pedestrian crossing upgrade

The State Government is improving passenger safety and accessibility by upgrading the southern pedestrian crossing at Nurlutta Railway Station.

What's happening

From mid-October, we will be undertaking service relocation works and minor rail track works. These activities are in preparation for works to upgrade the southern pedestrian crossing and access ramp to the station platform.

To allow these works to be safely undertaken, the pedestrian crossing on the southern side of Commercial Road will be temporarily closed from October to late November 2024, weather permitting. A detour will be in place to provide passengers with unimpeded access to the railway station.

From late-October until late November, we will demolish the existing pedestrian mazeway and construct a new one.

How this affects you

We will be working continuously during this time. There will be no impacts to passenger train services throughout the works.

There will be some light spill and noise disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the noise to a minimum.

Our site compound will be established on the southern side of Commercial Road near the pedestrian crossing.

There will be changes to traffic and pedestrian conditions to keep everyone safe while works are underway. Please follow traffic management directions while works are in progress.
