Barrier Highway Safety Upgrades

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades to the Barrier Highway

These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over 3 years.

What's happening

While we continue undertaking safety upgrades at various locations on the Barrier Highway, there will be a requirement for overnight lane closures so that pavement sealing can be undertaken.

How this affects you

The Barrier Highway will remain open at all times.

To undertake this work safely, the Barrier Highway will be reduced to a single lane of traffic for the duration of works. Traffic signals will be in place to direct the flow of traffic. Speed restrictions will also be in place throughout the work area. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers and follow onsite signage.

During the works, access to side roads within the work area may be temporarily restricted at times with detours in place as works move progressively along Barrier Highway. Advance notice of these closures will be provided via onsite signage.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
