

South Australian Rural Roads Safety Package

Pavement rehabilitation works

We are improving the safety and reliability of national freight routes.

The Australian and South Australian governments are funding a \$155 million package, on an 80:20 basis, focused on road safety outcomes on the regional and rural South Australian Road transport network.

What's happening

We are undertaking pavement rehabilitation on overtaking lanes between Lochiel and Redhill.

How this affects you

The Augusta Highway will remain open at all times.

To do this work safely, speed and lane restrictions will be in place throughout work areas with temporary traffic signals controlling the flow of traffic. Please plan your trips, be cautious around workers, and follow the speed limits and signage.

Outside of work hours lane closures will be lifted. Speed restrictions will remain in place at all times, including outside of work hours, until all works are completed in late February 2025.
