Mannum Road Remediation Works Notice

We are delivering road safety upgrades to Mannum Road

These works are jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) governments as part of the \$168 million National Road Safety Program over three years.

What's happening

Major works on Mannum Road between Mannum and Murray Bridge were completed in 2024.

Minor remediation works on Mannum Road between Mannum and Murray Bridge are now required.

How this affects you

Mannum Road will remain open at all times.

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restrictions will be in place during work hours, with temporary traffic signals in place to control the flow of traffic.

Outside of work hours two-way traffic will be reinstated and speed restrictions will be lifted. Please plan your trips, observe signage and follow the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

We thank you for your understanding while we complete these important safety upgrades.
