What's happening

Construction works to upgrade the Grange Road, Holbrooks Road and East Avenue Intersection are progressing well.

Activities will continue to increase across the site including median removal, installation of traffic barriers, street lighting and ongoing service utilities relocation works.

How this affects you

To keep everyone safe speed and lane restriction will be in place as required. Please follow traffic management and onsite signage.

Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons, there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained at all times. If there is a need for short-term access impacts, we will contact you directly in advance.

Access for emergency service vehicles will be maintained at all times.

Some noise disturbance can be expected; however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as is reasonably practicable.
