


# City Tram Extension Project

Early Works August-September 2017



The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of additional night works along North Terrace, between King William Road and East Terrace, and along King William Road, between North Terrace and the Adelaide Bridge on King William Road as part of the City Tram Extension.

These works are scheduled to commence from **Tuesday 15 August 2017** and be completed by **late September 2017**, weather permitting. The works will occur between the hours of 8pm and 6am, Sunday night to Friday morning.

Works will include:

- New kerb works requiring the temporary removal of street furniture on the southern side of North Terrace, Tuesday 15 August to Friday 29 September 2017.
- Light pole installation works to support the new overhead tram wires, Thursday 24 August to Friday 29 September 2017. Temporary lighting will be in operation during these works.
- Fire hydrant relocation works, Thursday 24 August to Monday 28 August 2017. Short-term water outages will be required at night for a small number of properties in the vicinity of the works. Advance notice will be provided to affected properties.

These works are being undertaken at night in order to minimise the impact to road users and to complete the works as safely and efficiently as possible. Access to businesses and properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. A 25km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents and businesses. However, some noise will be unavoidable during the works period.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
