Infrastructure works: June 2018

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to notify you of works planned on North Terrace to be undertaken by SA Power Networks as part of the City Tram Extension.

These works are scheduled to commence at **4am on Saturday 23 June 2018** and be completed by **6pm on Sunday 24 June 2018**, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken continuously throughout this period.

Works include modification to an existing High Voltage pit located between Charles Street and Gawler Place.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of each stage of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times. A 25km/h speed restriction will be in place while workers are on site.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained throughout the works.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents and businesses. However, some noise will be unavoidable during this period.

SA Power Networks will advise its customers directly of any planned or unplanned outages.

DPTI appreciates your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
