

South Australian Regional Bridge Upgrades

Bridge over Allen Creek, Thiele Highway (near Kapunda)

Works are continuing to upgrade the bridge over Allen Creek located on the Thiele Highway, just south of Kings Bridge Road. These works, being delivered by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport, will extend the service life of the structure and improve safety for road users.

To accommodate works for the bridge upgrade, a road closure will be in place on Thiele Highway, from Monday, 15 May 2023, for approximately two weeks, weather permitting.

During this time a temporary traffic detour will be in place for all vehicles via Main Street, Mildred Street, Marrabel Road, Kings Bridge Road and Thiele Highway (and vice versa). Please see map overleaf for details.

Work will be undertaken between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. Advanced notice will be provided if works are required at night or during the weekends.

Following the two-week detour period, the road will reopen with traffic reduced to a single lane. Temporary traffic signals will be in place to control the direction of traffic. Speed restrictions will also be in place throughout the work area for the remainder of the project.

Road users are asked to please plan ahead, expect delays, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Please observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access. Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residences and businesses, as much as practically possible. This project is expected to be completed in mid 2023, weather permitting.
