APPLICATION UNDER THE *FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act), dated 19 January 2023.

Your application seeks access to:

“Copies of all correspondence between the Minister for Energy and Mining’s Office, or anyone employed in the Ministerial Office and SA Power Networks, or anyone employed at SA Power Networks, between March 24 2022 and June 24 2022.”

An extension was sought to the 2 March 2023.

An extensive search was conducted within this office. A total of 6 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application.

I grant you access in full to 1 document; a copy of which is enclosed.

I grant you access in part to 3 documents; copies of which are enclosed.

I refuse you access in full to 2 documents.

Documents Released in Part

Documents 3, 4 and 6 are released in part as they contain mobile phone numbers and if released would involve the unreasonable disclosure of personal information. I therefore determine this information exempt pursuant to clause 6 to the FOI Act.

Documents Refused in Full

Documents 1 and 2 is correspondence between the Minister and the Chief Executive of SA Power Networks (SAPN) relating to Enterprise Agreement Negotiations. These documents clearly contain information concerning SAPN's business, professional, commercial and financial affairs.

This information is commercially sensitive as it may be deployed against SAPN in claims against it, thereby adversely impacting SAPN's financial position.

If this information was to disclosed to the public, this would adversely impact the open and frank disclosure to Government and SAPN would be reluctant to release internal documents and background information to Government, thereby delaying the ability of Government to receive and consider information.

Exemptions

Clause 6 – Documents affecting personal affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).

Clause 7– Documents affecting business affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document—
 - (a) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would disclose trade secrets of any agency or any other person; or
 - (b) if it contains matter—
 - (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets) that has a commercial value to any agency or any other person; and
 - (ii) the disclosure of which—
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to destroy or diminish the commercial value of the information; and
 - (B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest; or
 - (c) if it contains matter—
 - (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets or information referred to in paragraph (b)) concerning the business, professional, commercial or financial affairs of any agency or any other person; and
 - (ii) the disclosure of which—
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to have an adverse effect on those affairs or to prejudice the future supply of such information to the Government or to an agency; and

(B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

No fees and charges are payable for this application.

If you are unhappy with this determination you are entitled to apply for an internal review, in accordance with section 29 of the FOI Act. To make an internal review application, please either write a letter or complete *Application for Review of Determination* form, to the Principal Officer of this agency, the Hon Tom Koutsantonis MP, within 30 (calendar) days after you receive this letter.

Hi Peter,

Thank you for making the time to catch up yesterday, especially given you're only a few weeks into getting set up and have a huge list of priorities – greatly appreciated.

I committed to sending through a formal follow-up on a couple of key engagements which SAPN would really value the Minister's Office being involved in:

- The Transition Steering Group – The next meeting is April 28th at 10 am (would be great to have you and/or the Advisor there). SAPN's GM Strategy and Transformation, Mark Vincent, will send you an invitation/agenda for consideration.
- A regular (perhaps quarterly) "coffee catch-up" between the Minister and one of SAPN's Executive. I'll await your advice on the Minister's interest before we extend formal invitations/liase with your office.
- Government/industry collaboration on a long-term SA *Energy Vision*. We would like to raise this formally with the Minister when we have the opportunity to meet him, and I'll await your advice on whether he is interested in that conversation.
- Our CEO Rob Stobbe has extended a formal letter/mtg request to the Minister, via your email and the Ministerial email address
- If or when you/your staff are interested, our GMs Network Management (Doug Schmidt) and Strategy and Transformation (Mark Vincent) would be pleased to do a few "show and tell" sessions on key topics, including but not limited to a tour of our Network Innovation Centre, which gives some great practical insight into the future of energy distribution. That is an open offer which I will leave with you and perhaps follow up in a while when things are more settled.

As we also discussed yesterday, an important part of our engagement will be reaching out to MP's and their staff more broadly for *general* information sessions. Appreciating the broad social/environmental/economic impacts of the energy transition, we hope that providing information in those forums will help our representatives in Parliament to consider the "energy overlay" of other policy and legislative decisions.

I've taken the liberty of copying Carly McNeill into this email, to assist in triaging these invitations.

Dear Minister

I write to congratulate you on the South Australian Labor Party's success in forming Government at the recent State Election. SA Power Networks is extremely encouraged by the Malinauskas Government's focus on planning for the longer-term.

As you are aware, our clean energy transition provides a major opportunity to boost our State's economy as well as community health and well-being. Through your long-term work in the energy portfolio, you no doubt also are aware of the range of opportunities, barriers and risks of such a transition.
