APPLICATION UNDER THE *FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 1991*

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act), dated 19 January 2023.

Your application seeks access to:

“Copies of all correspondence between the Minister for Energy and Mining’s Office, or anyone employed in the Ministerial Office and SA Power Networks, or anyone employed at SA Power Networks, between September 24 2022 and December 31 2022.”

An extension was sought to the 16 March 2023.

An extensive search was conducted within this office. A total of 44 documents were identified as answering the terms of your application.

I grant you access in full to 1 document; a copy of which is enclosed.
I grant you access in part to 4 documents; a copy of which is enclosed.
I refuse you access in full to 39 documents.

Documents Released in Part

Documents 41, 42, 43 and 44 are released in part as it contains mobile phone numbers and if released would involve the unreasonable disclosure of personal information. I therefore determine this information exempt pursuant to clause 6 to the FOI Act.

Documents Refused in Full

Documents 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 33, 34, 35, 36, 38, 39 and 40 are all emails between this office and SA Power Networks (SAPN) which contains information relating to –

- Ministerial meetings and discussions;
- Electricity assets and connected customers, location of assets and customers;
- Internal electricity connection and disconnection processes and decisions;
- Condition of network assets.

This information clearly constitutes information concerning the business, professional and financial affairs of SAPN and is commercially sensitive as it may be deployed against SAPN in subsequent litigation.

If this information was to be disclosed to the public, this would adversely impact the open and frank disclosure to Government and SAPN would be reluctant to release internal documents and background information to Government, that is potentially prejudicial to SAPN.

This would compromise the ability of the Government to ensure the safe and efficient supply of electricity; impair the timing of SAPN's decision making processes and disclose confidential information regarding location and features of the electricity network, which could result in network security risks.

I therefore determine that these documents are exempt in full pursuant to clause 7(1)(c) and clause 13.

Document 13 is an email between the Minister's Office and SAPN. This is an internal working document which contains opinions which were considered for the purpose of decision making relating to the functions of government. It is not in the public interest to disclose the content of these documents as it is important for the Government to receive frank and comprehensive advice and opinions, including the expression of views which may be contentious. I therefore determine this information exempt pursuant to clause 9.

Information about electricity distribution networks is considered sensitive and its confidentiality protected. This view is consistent with the policy behind the *Security of Critical Infrastructure Act 2018* (Cth) (SoCI Act).

The SoCI Act recognises the security risk associated with electricity distributors and information about distribution networks and the risks if this information is disclosed. SAPN's network assets and information are considered to be of importance to the safety, security and prosperity of the community, and therefore must be kept protected and secure from misuse.

Documents 2, 16, 20, 21, 24 and 37 are all emails relating to public safety announcements which were publicised either through the media or social media. I determine this information exempt as its publicly available information.

Exemptions

Clause 6 – Documents affecting personal affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).

Clause 7– Documents affecting business affairs

- (1) A document is an exempt document—
 - (a) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would disclose trade secrets of any agency or any other person; or
 - (b) if it contains matter—
 - (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets) that has a commercial value to any agency or any other person; and
 - (ii) the disclosure of which—
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to destroy or diminish the commercial value of the information; and
 - (B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest; or
 - (c) if it contains matter—
 - (i) consisting of information (other than trade secrets or information referred to in paragraph (b)) concerning the business, professional, commercial or financial affairs of any agency or any other person; and
 - (ii) the disclosure of which—
 - (A) could reasonably be expected to have an adverse effect on those affairs or to prejudice the future supply of such information to the Government or to an agency; and
 - (B) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

Clause 9 – Internal working documents

- (1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter—
 - (a) that relates to—
 - (i) any opinion, advice or recommendation that has been obtained, prepared or recorded; or
 - (ii) any consultation or deliberation that has taken place,
in the course of, or for the purpose of, the decision-making functions of the Government, a Minister or an agency; and
 - (b) the disclosure of which would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.

13 – Documents containing confidential material

- (1) A document is an exempt document—
- (a) if it contains matter the disclosure of which would found an action for breach of confidence; or
 - (b) if it contains matter obtained in confidence the disclosure of which—
 - (i) might reasonably be expected to prejudice the future supply of such information to the Government or to an agency; and
 - (ii) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest.
