

# Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

## Ongoing night works

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

Night works will continue to be undertaken as required until project completion in late 2023, weather permitting.

The information below provides an update on the status of construction works to date and key works planned during September and October 2023, weather permitting. Future updates will be provided outlining progress and upcoming night works as the project continues.

### Ongoing works

- Construction of central road medians on Glen Osmond Road east and Fullarton Road south of the intersection.
- Continued road pavement rehabilitation and commencement of final wearing course (asphalt works).
- Completion of the Main Ave junction.
- Completion of drainage works on Fullarton Road south and Glen Osmond Road east of the intersection.
- Installation of new road signage, line marking and final traffic signal works.
- Construction of footpath pavements, kerbing and driveway crossovers at various location around the intersection, along the south side of Glen Osmond Road and the south western side of Fullarton Road.
- Installation of urban design elements (landscaping).

### Hours of work

To minimise impacts to road users, the majority of work will continue to be undertaken at night between 7pm and 6am, Sunday to Thursday, as required. No work will be undertaken at night on Friday and Saturday nights.

Some intermittent works will also continue to be undertaken during the day between 7am – 5pm, Monday to Saturday, as required.

### Pedestrian and cyclist access changes

Some temporary pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the works site and pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care and follow directional signage when travelling through the area.

### Traffic changes

During the works, the intersection will remain open to traffic at all times.

To safely undertake these works, lane and speed restrictions will be in place along Glen Osmond Road, Fullarton Road and intersecting side streets. Local road closures may be required during works and local detours will be in place. Advance notice will be provided.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site.

Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained. In the event that access restrictions are necessary, property owners will be notified in advance by the project team.

### **Noise and vibration**

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible. This includes scheduling intrusive works early evening where possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
