

Tea Tree Plaza Park n Ride

Project Update – February 2024



The new four level Park 'n' Ride facility (ground floor plus three upper floors) opened on Friday 16 February 2024.

We have increased parking spaces from 700 to approximately 1,200.

The upgrade aims to meet demand for Park 'n' Ride commuters and increase public transport usage in the north-eastern suburbs.

We would like to thank you for your patience and support while we built this important project.

Minor works continuing

We are still finishing some minor works until mid-2024, this includes fencing and landscaping, minor pathway works as well as artwork installation.

Pedestrians and cyclists might need to use a different path during the works. Signs will be in place to show you where to go.

Access to new parking spaces

You can access the new carpark from the existing Park 'n' Ride entrance located on the Busway Access Road off Smart Road. Vehicles can enter the new parking areas through the existing Park 'n' Ride by using the new ramp linking between the two buildings. There will be signage to show you how many parking spaces are available within the new carpark.

Pedestrians can access the interchange from the new carpark via a new walkway that leads into the existing Park 'n' Ride.

The existing car park entrance has also been upgraded, with new boom gates. The second exit lane has been extended along the full eastern length of the Park 'n' Ride & Busway Access Road to create a three-lane roadway, removing the need to merge immediately into one exit lane when leaving the car park.
