

John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade

Early works - night works

We are working to improve safety and reduce delays at the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road at Elizabeth Vale. This project is part of the State Government's election commitment, to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and make travel easier for all users.

What's happening:

Prior to the commencement of construction works, and to help inform the final design, we will be undertaking site investigation and service location night works. To enable these works to be undertaken a small amount of vegetation clearing is required near the corner of John Rice Avenue and Winklebury Drive, Elizabeth Vale. We will ensure we minimise any impacts.

How this affects you:

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place on John Rice Avenue (near the existing pedestrian crossing). Please follow the directions of onsite traffic controllers and observe traffic signage when travelling through the area.

For safety reasons there may be some restricted access for pedestrians and cyclists. When required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours. Every effort will be made to minimise impacts to the community.

We will have more information about this project including the final when construction is expected to commence in the coming months.
