

Long Valley Road Improvement Works

Works notice

We are continuing to undertake road improvements on Long Valley Road between Wistow and Strathalbyn. Works will improve safety for all road users.

What's happening:

We are undertaking pavement remediation works on the southbound overtaking lane between the Steam Ranger railway line and Gemmells Road on Long Valley Road. We are also undertaking resealing works on Long Valley Road, between Bunnett Road and Wellington Road.

How this affects you:

To safely undertake these works, speed and lane restrictions will be in place with traffic controllers in place to control the direction of traffic. Outside of working hours speed and lane restrictions will also remain in place subject to onsite conditions.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, advance notice will be provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times during these works; however, works will be managed to minimise disturbance as much as practically possible. You may also notice some odour which is common when asphaltting works are underway.

Access for public transport and emergency services will be maintained at all times.

Works at the southbound overtaking lane between Gemmells Road and Mine Flat Road are continuing and are on schedule to be completed in mid-2024, weather permitting.
