# St Bernards Road Pedestrian Refuge Upgrade

Works update

We are delivering critical road safety upgrades and improvements on remote, regional, urban roads, footpaths and cycle paths around South Australia.

The \$168 million Road Safety Program is jointly funded by the Australian (50%) and South Australian (50%) Governments over three years.

## What's happening

Works will commence shortly on St Bernards Road, Rostrevor to improve safety and connection to the Fourth Creek Trail. The project will include:

- construction of a new pedestrian refuge, with new pedestrian ramps on both approaches to the refuge.
- installation of a new pedestrian ramp on St Bernards
  Road at the corner of Leabrook Drive.
- upgrades to existing street lighting.
- new line marking and road signage.

St Bernards Road will remain open to traffic at all times during the works.

St Bernards Road, adjacent Leabrook Drive in Rostrevor

# How this affects you

To do this work safely we'll have speed and lane restrictions in place in work areas. Please follow onsite signage and traffic management directions while works are in progress.

Pedestrians and cyclists, please be cautious when passing through the area. Some areas might have restricted access for safety; however, traffic controllers will be on site to show you where to go. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access.

There may be some noise from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep the disruption to a minimum.

Access for public transport will be maintained, however, please check the latest updates on scheduled services at adelaidemetro.com.au

You will still be able to access homes and properties. If we need to limit or impact access, we'll contact property owners know ahead of time. Outside of work hours speed restrictions will remain in place subject to onsite conditions until project completion.
