Pedestrian Actuated Crossing (PAC) - works notice

We're making it easier for pedestrians to cross busy main roads

Works on the new PAC on Grange Road are nearing completion. The new PAC will make crossing Grange Road safer and more convenient, improving community access to local shops, schools, particularly for school children accessing Allenby Gardens Primary School and bus services.

What's happening

To minimise disruption to all road users, final traffic light signalling, asphalting and line marking works will be undertaken at night between 7pm to 6am, weather permitting. Intermittent day works will also continue during this period.

Day works will continue to complete the kerb, footpath reinstatement and signage works. These works will be undertaken Monday to Friday, between 7am to 5pm, weather permitting.

How this affects you

Grange Road will remain open at all times. To keep everyone safe, we will have speed and lane restrictions in place throughout the work zone as needed. Please observe onsite signage and direction of traffic controllers.
