

Churchill Road Pocket Park

Works update

We are creating a Pocket Park near the new Torrens Road bridge, returning vacant land to the community to be used as open green space. The pocket park will be located at Churchill Road in Ovingham.

Pocket parks enhance lifestyle and community connectivity. They are visually pleasing and support a safe and connected transport network.

What's happening

We will be starting works on the Churchill Road Pocket Park during the week commencing 6 January 2025.

These works will include site preparation works, installation of plant materials, environmental works, installation of retaining walls, installation of stormwater infrastructure, new pavements for paving and pathways and installation of park furniture.

How this affects you

Pedestrians and cyclists may be required to use a different path during the works. Signs will be in place to show you where to go.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works wherever possible, with advance notice provided if there is a need to temporarily restrict driveway access.
