

John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road Junction Upgrade

Temporary road closures and bus detours

We are upgrading the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road in Elizabeth Vale

This upgrade forms part of the State Government's election commitments, to upgrade, or investigate potential upgrades, in the northern suburbs to improve safety, access and to make travel easier for all users.

What's happening

Works are continuing at the junction of John Rice Avenue and Haydown Road in Elizabeth Vale.

Asphalting work will be undertaken on Haydown Road and Winklebury Road for approximately three nights.

How this affects you

To undertake this work safely, the following **road closures** will be in place at night:

- Haydown Road, at the John Rice Avenue junction, will be closed to all traffic.
- Winklebury Road, at the John Rice Avenue junction, will be closed to all traffic.

Access to John Rice Avenue will be maintained via local road detours.

Local detours will be in place during closures. Please follow onsite signage for alternative routes and observe the direction of onsite traffic controllers.

John Rice Avenue will remain open with temporary speed and lane restrictions in place.

From Tuesday 21 January 2025 to Tuesday 28 January 2025 there will be **temporary parking restrictions on Rollison Road and Osler Street.**

Bus stop 54B (both sides) on Haydown Road will be impacted at night during works. Please refer to bus stop signage and check the latest updates at adelaidemetro.com.au for more information.

Access for emergency service vehicles will be available at all times.

Access to properties will be maintained, with advance notice to be provided if there are any requirements to temporarily restrict access.

Outside of these works, speed and lane restrictions will remain in place throughout the work area for the duration of the project, until complete.

Day work will continue between 7am and 5pm.

This project is expected to be complete March 2025, weather permitting.
