

Grange Road, Holbrooks Road and East Avenue intersection upgrade

Landscaping Fact Sheet

We're upgrading the Holbrooks Road and East Avenue intersection to make it easier for you to cross Grange Road.

Landscape plan

As part of the project, new landscaping will be planted within the project area, incorporating approximately 80 semi-mature trees and over 870 shrubs.

Once established, the new landscaping will increase footpath shade, street appeal and enhance local biodiversity.

The landscape design and plant selection will complement the local biodiversity, assisted by careful selection of trees and shrubs suitable to the area.

Landscaping works will commence later in the year and continue until project completion, expected in late 2025, weather permitting.
