

Torrens Rail Junction project



Night works on Park Terrace and in the Park Lands

On 19 December 2016, the State and Federal governments awarded an Alliance contract to Laing O'Rourke, AECOM and KBR to design and construct the Torrens Rail Junction Project.

The project will remove major pinch points in the rail freight and road network to increase the flow of freight on the Perth-Adelaide-Melbourne national rail line. It will separate the interstate freight rail line from the Outer Harbor passenger line and build a rail underpass at Park Terrace. The project will also feature a new lowered railway station at Bowden, improving connections to the Bowden Urban Village, Entertainment Centre, Park Lands and local area, including a new shared use path.

Night works on Park Terrace are required to relocate the boom gates and signals at the existing level crossing to prepare for construction of the new underpass. To minimise disruption to road users these works will be undertaken at night from **8pm – 6am Wednesday 4 January to Friday 20 January 2017**, subject to weather. Speed and lane restrictions will be in place on Park Terrace, however the road will remain open to traffic in both directions at all times.

Night works are also required to install signalling conduits under the rail tracks next to the Torrens River Rail Bridge and Bonython Park. Construction will occur **from 8pm to 6am Saturday 14 January to Monday 16 January 2017**, subject to weather. Trucks and under boring equipment will access the work site via War Memorial Drive.

Night works will be managed to minimise disturbance to the local community as much as possible.

Planned day works in January 2017 include surveying and service deepthing activities in Bowden and the Park Lands.

Speed and lane restrictions will apply in the vicinity of the works and signage will alert motorists, cyclists and pedestrians to changed traffic conditions. Traffic controllers will be in place during the works to assist motorists and residents as required.
