

## Operation Moving Traffic: Improvements to Hackney Road and Mann Road, North Adelaide

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) will be improving the operation of Hackney Road and Mann Road, North Adelaide, as part of Operation Moving Traffic.

Operation Moving Traffic (OMT) is a South Australian Government initiative launched in 2015 to improve the efficiency, reliability and safety of the transport network, which includes both roads and public transport and extends across Greater Adelaide.

The purpose of these works is to improve traffic distribution and lane utilisation, minimise lane weaving manoeuvres and improve traffic flow on Hackney Road and Mann Road, as well as improve recognition and raise public awareness of the wider City Ring Route.

The works will involve the installation of new pavement marking along Mann Road and modifications to existing signage along Hackney Road and Mann Road, North Adelaide. A concept plan is attached for your information.

Works are scheduled to commence on **Sunday 14 May 2017** and are expected to be completed by **Thursday 18 May 2017**, weather permitting.

The associated line marking works will be undertaken each night between the hours of 8.30pm and 3am, Sunday 14 May to 3am Thursday 18 May, 2017. These works will be undertaken at night to minimise the impact to road users and to complete the works safely and efficiently. Associated sign modification works will be undertaken during the day between the hours of 9am and 4pm on Monday 15 May and Tuesday 16 May 2017.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place in the vicinity of the works, however the road will remain open to traffic at all times. Other restrictions may apply subject to onsite conditions.

Signage will be in place to advise motorists of the changed traffic conditions. Road users are requested to take extra care when workers are in the area and observe traffic signage and speed restrictions.

Some noise may be experienced while works are completed, however every effort will be made to minimise disturbance to local residents.
