Girder Installation – weekend road closure Main South Road (southbound) surface road December 2019

As part of the Flinders Link Project, steel girders are required to be installed across Main South Road and the lowered motorway to form the base of the elevated bridge deck.

20 steel bridge girders, ranging in length between 30-50 metres, will form the 10 spans to be installed as part of the project.

Each span requires two steel girders to be lifted into place using two cranes which are then placed on top of the piers and abutments to form the base of the bridge deck.

Span 10 Girder Installation

This fact sheet provides details of the weekend closure required for the installation of span 10 across Main South Road (southbound) surface road.

As part of the weekend closure two girders and a quantity of pre-cast concrete deck panels are required to be lifted into place.

Between 8pm on Friday 6 December, to 6am on Monday 9 December 2019, the Main South Road (southbound) surface road between Sturt Road and Flinders Drive will be closed.

A detour for Main South Road (southbound) traffic will be in place via Sturt Road and Marion Road. The Southern Expressway will remain operational with southbound traffic required to enter at the Marion Road ramp. Access will still be maintained at the Flinders Drive on ramp for access to the lowered motorway.

Please refer to the map for further details of the closure.

Two further closures of Main South Road and the lowered motorway will be required in early 2020. Information will be provided in advance of these dates.

Emergency and hospital access

Access for emergency services vehicles will be maintained at all times during the closure period via Sturt Road and Laffer Drive. Access across the Flinders Drive Bridge and onto Flinders Drive will also be maintained at all times throughout the weekend closure.

Northbound motorists will still have access to the hospital via the dedicated right turn lane from Main South Road and the Southern Expressway onto Flinders Drive at all times.

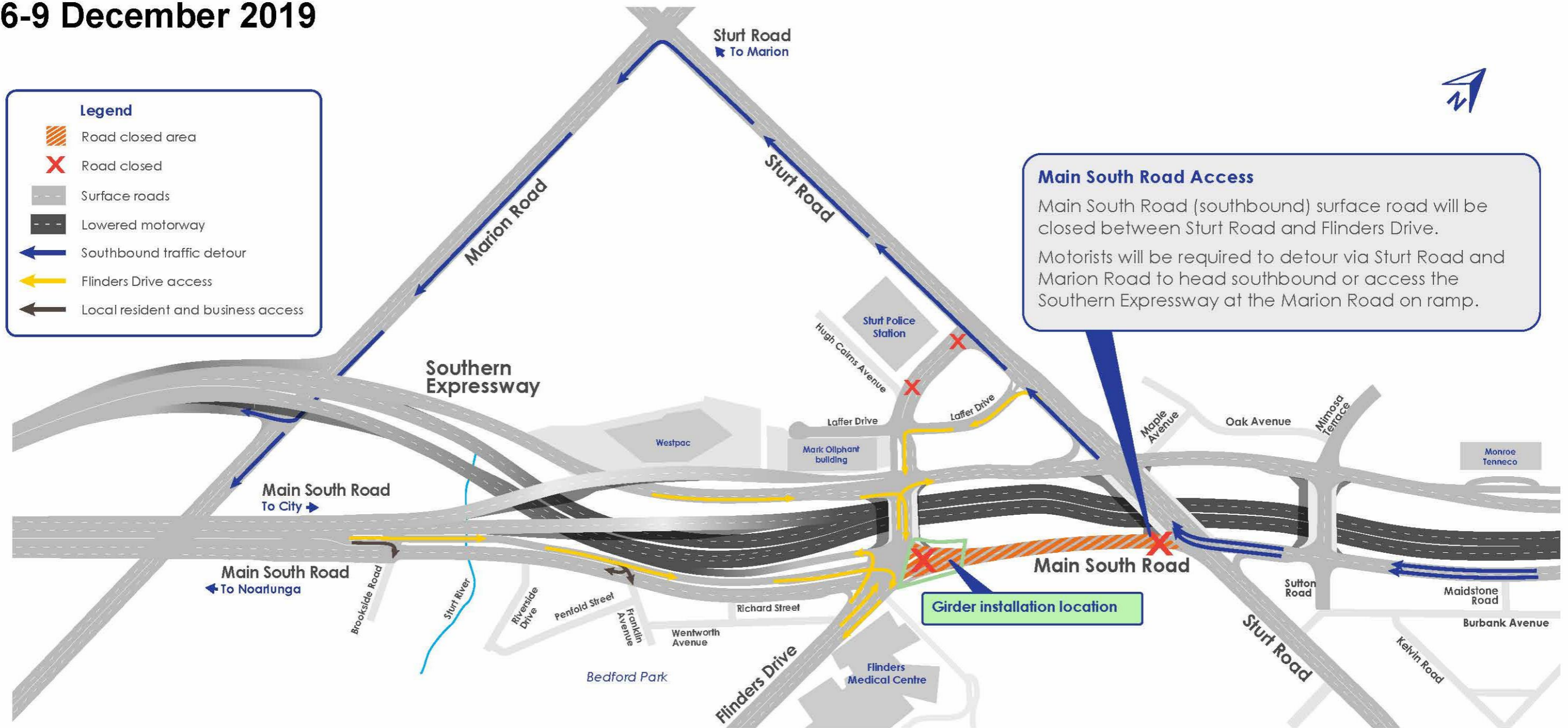

Main South Road Access

Main South Road (southbound) surface road will be closed between Sturt Road and Flinders Drive.

Motorists will be required to detour via Sturt Road and Marion Road to head southbound or access the Southern Expressway at the Marion Road on ramp.



Access to the hospital for southbound motorists will be via Sturt Road, then left onto Laffer Drive.

On-site traffic controllers will be in place to direct vehicles as required.

Local resident and business access

Access for residents and businesses will be maintained at all times during the closure period.

Motorists will be able to turn right from Main South Road into Franklin Avenue and Brookside Road. A U-turn facility is available at Franklin Avenue to access the businesses along Main South Road.

Bedford Park residents wishing to travel northbound will be able to turn right from Flinders Drive onto Main South Road.

Pedestrian and cyclists

Pedestrians are reminded to keep clear of the work zones, however traffic management will be in place throughout the closure to assist with pedestrian movements.

During the closure cyclists will be detoured via Sturt Road and Marion Road as per the detour for motorists.

Bus users

As part of the weekend closure all existing bus stops will be serviced during the detour.

Services will be required to detour via Sturt Road, Laffer Drive and across Flinders Drive Bridge onto Flinders Drive.
