Main South Road night works

As part of the Darlington Upgrade Project, night works will be undertaken to install a gantry sign on Main South Road, requiring a temporary closure of Main South Road (northbound) surface road between Sturt Road and the Tonsley Boulevard exit ramp from 8pm, Tuesday 10 March, until 6am, Wednesday, 11 March. Please see map overleaf for further details.

Traffic restrictions:

- The northbound Main South Road surface road will be closed between Sturt Road and the Tonsley Boulevard exit ramp.
- Northbound traffic will be detoured via Sturt Road and Shepherds Hill Road (see pink arrows on the map overleaf).
- Access to Flinders Drive will not be impacted during these works (see orange arrows on the map overleaf).
- Bus stop 26 on the western side of Main South Road will remain open during these works with services detoured via Main South Road, Sturt Road and Shepherds Hill Road.
- Bus Stop 24A on the western side of South Road will be temporarily closed during these works.

Local residents in the Tonsley triangle are reminded that the Mimosa Terrace / Sutton Road bridge is now operational, which provides access to Sturt Road and Shepherds Hill Road to travel northbound on South Road.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
