

Mitcham Hills Corridor - Old Belair Road Upgrades - Proposed Treatments

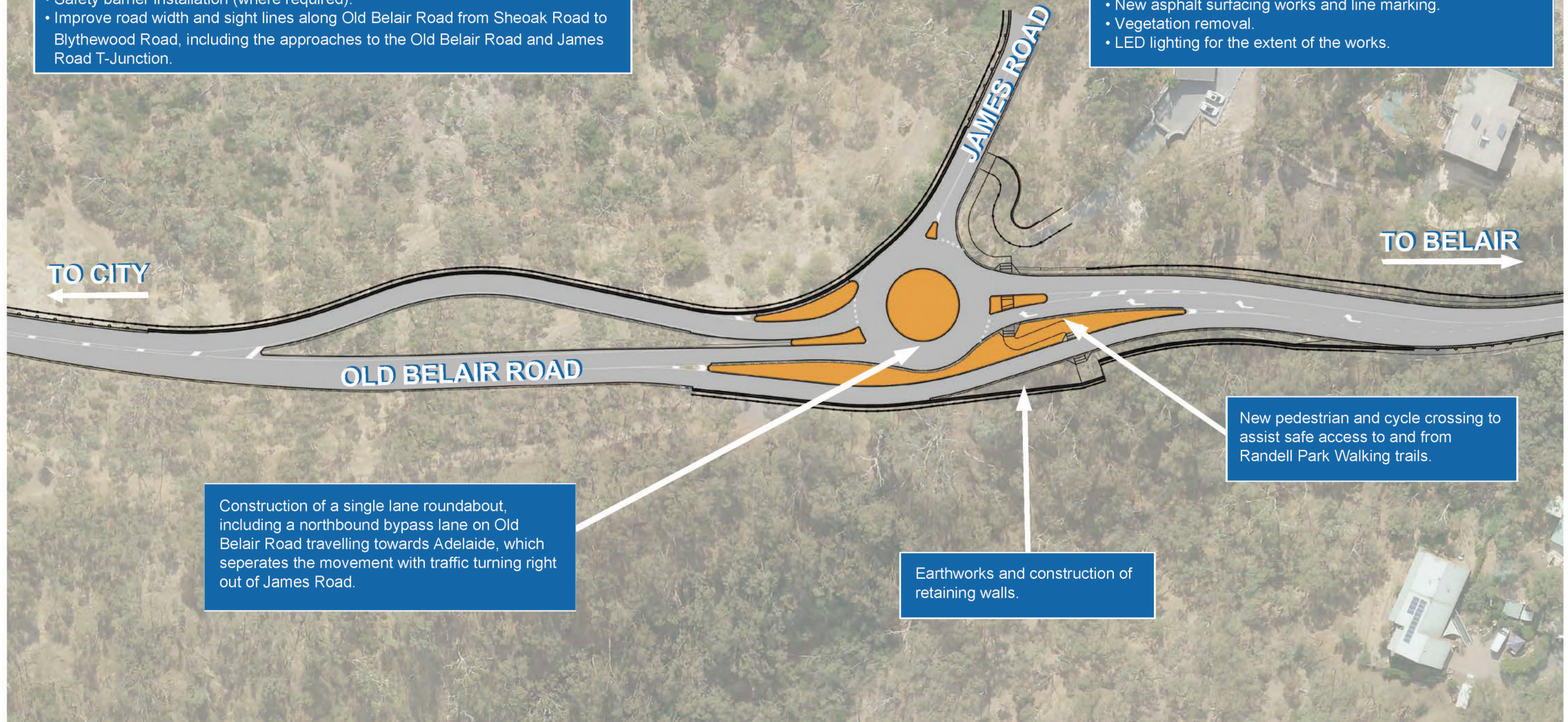


Other improvements along Old Belair Road (as part of the Mitcham Hills Corridor Upgrade) will also be undertaken (between Sheoak Road and Blythwood Road) as part of this project. These include:

- Localised curve widening.
- New LED lighting (where required).
- Safety barrier installation (where required).
- Improve road width and sight lines along Old Belair Road from Sheoak Road to Blythwood Road, including the approaches to the Old Belair Road and James Road T-Junction.

Other proposed treatments as part of the Old Belair Road and James Road T-Junction upgrade include:

- New and upgraded drainage including new kerb and gutter.
- New asphalt surfacing works and line marking.
- Vegetation removal.
- LED lighting for the extent of the works.



Construction of a single lane roundabout, including a northbound bypass lane on Old Belair Road travelling towards Adelaide, which separates the movement with traffic turning right out of James Road.

Earthworks and construction of retaining walls.

New pedestrian and cycle crossing to assist safe access to and from Randell Park Walking trails.
