

Flagstaff Road Upgrade

The upgrade of Flagstaff Road, between Hyland Avenue and Bonneyview Road, will install a fourth lane to make it a permanent two-way dual carriageway. The South Australian Government has committed \$32.9 million towards the project.

The upgrade will also include a shared use path and bicycle lane to improve safety and connectivity.

A new shared use path and bicycle lane

Community feedback received has assisted in informing the design which includes:

- A new shared use path on the eastern side of Flagstaff Road (between Hyland Avenue and Bonneyview Road) matching into the existing bicycle lane and footpath; and
- A new on-road northbound bicycle lane on Flagstaff Road (between Bonneyview Road and Hyland Avenue) connecting to the Main South Road intersection off-road bicycle and pedestrian path (at the northern end) and the existing northbound bicycle lane (at the southern end).

Temporary impacts during construction

To safely facilitate construction, the informal walking trail on the eastern side of Flagstaff Road and the southbound bike lane, between Hyland Avenue and Bonneyview Road, will be closed until late 2021. Pedestrians and cyclists are encouraged to use the detours in place and take care when travelling in the area. The bicycle detour will be via Black Road and Main South Road.

At completion of this stage of construction the shared use path will be open and the construction zone moved to the western side of Flagstaff Road.
