

Military Road Pedestrian Actuated Crossing

Early works

As part of the State Government's election commitment to enhancing pedestrian safety, the Department for Infrastructure and Transport will design and install a pedestrian actuated crossing on Military Road. Funding of \$1.1 million has been allocated to this project.

The pedestrian actuated crossing will be installed on Military Road between St Albans Terrace and Recreation Parade, immediately to the north of Jena Close. The new crossing will improve access to Point Malcolm Reserve and contribute to improved safety when crossing Military Road.

What to expect

Early works and service relocations are scheduled to commence in the coming weeks and are expected to be completed by **Friday, 19 May 2023**. Works will be undertaken Monday to Friday between the hours of 7am and 5pm, weather permitting. No works will be undertaken on weekends.

Works will include the relocation of telecommunications and APA Gas infrastructure. Individual service providers, including APA Gas and Telecommunications providers, will advise separately of any potential interruptions to services during these works.

There will be no impact on traffic however the footpath will be temporarily closed for the duration of the works, which is up to two days following each of the relocations. Temporary pedestrian detours will be in place around the work sites and pedestrians are advised to follow directional signage.

Some noise disturbance can be expected at times while these works are completed, however the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Construction of this pedestrian actuated crossing is expected to commence in **mid- 2023** and will be **completed by late 2023**. Advance notification of these works will be provided.

The Department appreciates your co-operation and patience while these important works are undertaken.
