## Bookpurnong Road works notice

### We are undertaking flood recovery works on Bookpurnong Road

These works are funded as part of the River Murray Flood Recovery Program.

### What's happening

Resurfacing works are being undertaken along Bookpurnong Road, between Kemp Road and Gurra Gurra Bridge, Gurra Gurra. These works will improve safety and amenity for all road users.

### How this affects you

#### Bookpurnong Road will remain open at all times.

To keep everyone safe while we undertake these works, there will be changes to traffic conditions. During working hours Bookpurnong Road will be reduced to a single lane under speed restrictions. Traffic signals will be in place to guide the flow of traffic.

Outside of working hours speed restrictions will remain in place throughout the area the duration of the project. Please plan your trips, observe onsite signage and the follow direction of traffic controllers.

There might be some noisy disruptions from time to time, but we'll do our best to keep impacts to a minimum. You may also notice some odours, which is normal during spray sealing works.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained. If temporary access restrictions are required affected property owners, residents and businesses will be contacted directly in advance.
