

Active Pedestrian Crossing

Jane Street, West Croydon

The State Government is improving safety and accessibility along the rail network by constructing an Activated Pedestrian Crossing at Jane Street, West Croydon.

What's happening

There will be a full line closure from the **last train service on Friday 13 December 2024**, until the **first train service Monday 16 December**.

We will be installing pedestrian crossing components, removing the existing pedestrian crossing and undertaking signalling works.

We will be working in the rail corridor, using hi-rail machinery, between the level crossing at Coglein Street and Jane Street, Woodville Park Railway Station.

Test trains will be operating between Bowden Railway Station and Woodville Railway Station.

How this affects you

You may experience low-level vibration and noise from rail equipment, machinery, vehicle movements and essential communication between workers. However, every effort will be made to minimise disruption to residents during these works.

The existing Jane Street pedestrian crossing will be closed during these works. Pedestrians and cyclists are asked to use the West Croydon Railway Station subway or the pedestrian crossing at Brown Street and Malcolm Street as detours.

Temporary lighting towers will be used at night to ensure safe working conditions for the team. We will ensure the lights are directed towards the work area.
