

City Tram Extension Project

Construction update – Stage 3
22 October to 6 November 2017

The State Government has committed \$80 million in funding for the first stage of the AdeLINK tram network to the city's East End, including the purchase of three additional trams.

This project will deliver a one-kilometre extension of the tram line along North Terrace, from King William Street to East Terrace, and approximately a 350 metre extension north along King William Road to the Festival Plaza Precinct.

This newsletter provides an update on Stage 3 – King William Road.

Project Staging

The project has been staged to minimise disruption where possible to Christmas retail, events and cultural and university calendars. The project will be constructed in five stages:

Stage 1: Early works
Ongoing

Stage 2: North Terrace
1 to 16 October 2017

Stage 3: King William Road
22 October to 6 November 2017

Stage 4: North Terrace/King William Street intersection
3 to 15 January - Works completed in time for the Tour Down Under

Stage 5: Night-time finishing works
First quarter of 2018

Commencement of new tram services

Whilst the majority of works will be completed in January 2018, there will be a period of commissioning and testing before trams can start taking passengers on the new line.

Stage 3 – King William Road 22 October - 6 November 2017

Stage 3 will involve the installation of tram tracks along King William Road between North Terrace and the Adelaide Festival Plaza Precinct.

Stage 3 works will be undertaken from 22 October to 6 November 2017, with works occurring 24 hours a day.

Undertaking these works 24 hours a day will assist to minimise disruption. Construction of the Festival Plaza Precinct tram stop will occur after the Tour Down Under in January 2018.

Local Access

During Stage 3 the right turn into Festival Drive will be temporarily removed.

The u-turn facility near the Festival Plaza will be permanently removed.

Traffic, pedestrians and cyclists

Traffic along King William Road will be restricted to two lanes in each direction for the duration of the works.

Access along King William Road footpaths will be maintained for the duration of Stage 3. The pedestrian crossing at the Festival Centre will be temporarily removed for the duration of the works.

Tram and bus services

During Stage 3, tram and bus services will not be affected.

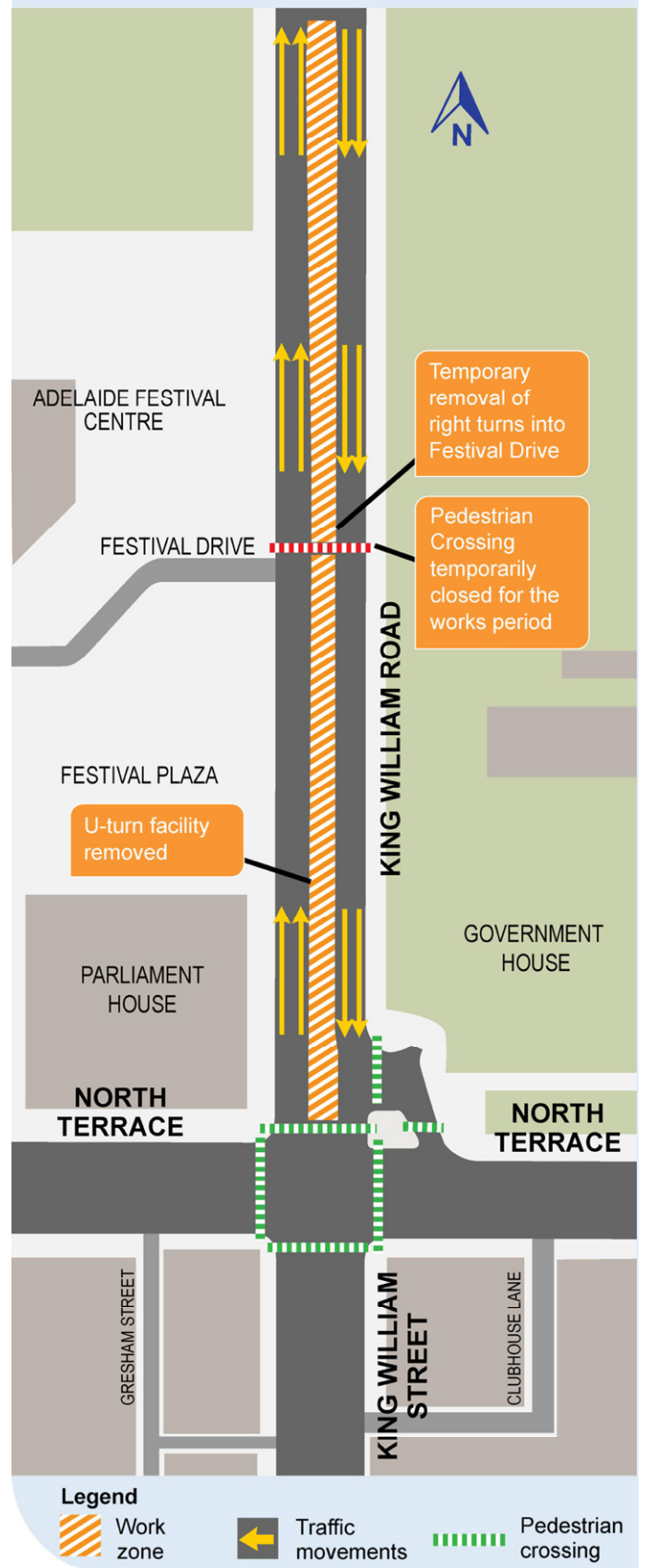
