Vegetation removals – Tuesday, 4 August

Woodland Road, Mitchell Park

As part of the Flinders Link Project, vegetation removals will occur along Woodland Road, Mitchell Park, adjacent to the rail corridor.

Small sections of vegetation will be removed to allow for; construction of the new Tonsley Railway Station Active Pedestrian Crossing, installation of power and water connections, drainage and a rail access gate, which will occur in the coming months.

Vegetation removals will be undertaken on Tuesday, 4 August, between 7am and 5pm.

All efforts will be made to minimise impacts to vegetation with replacement planting to occur as part of the project, which will be included in the final landscaping design.

Traffic restrictions will be in place while these works are undertaken. Please take extra care when workers are on site and observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Traffic controllers will ensure that access to properties along Woodland Road is maintained at all times for residents. Pedestrians are reminded to keep clear of the work zones.
