Night Works

As part of the Flinders Link Project, night works will be undertaken within the rail corridor of the Tonsley rail line for the decommissioning of the Clovelly Park Railway Station and commissioning of the new Flinders rail line.

When: from Tuesday, 17 November to Wednesday, 25 November 2020, between 7pm and 7am.

Where: within the rail corridor of the Tonsley rail line, localised around the Clovelly Park Railway Station.

Works will involve:

- signalling power change-over and communication connections;
- overhead wiring and preparation works;
- demolition of the Clovelly Park Railway Station;
- commissioning works for the new Flinders rail line; and
- track tamping.

Some noise disturbance and low level vibration can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Reversing beepers on worksite vehicles may be disruptive, however to ensure safety onsite during the works, they cannot be switched off. As the crews move along the rail line, you may experience medium to high levels of noise when the tamping machinery is in close proximity to your property.

Road closures

There are no planned road closures, however, localised traffic management will be in place during the works.

Please observe signage and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout the works. Pedestrian access will not be affected by these works.
