Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade Project update

Dear Stakeholder,

The Australian and South Australian governments have jointly committed \$40 million (50:50) to undertake a number of improvements along the Mitcham Hills Road Corridor to improve safety and traffic flow along Old Belair Road.

Thank you to those members of the community who attended our recent Mitcham Hills Road Corridor Upgrade information sessions at the Blackwood Bowling Club in November 2021.

We are now progressing the relevant legislative environmental approvals. Construction of the Old Belair Road and James Road junction upgrade is scheduled to commence early 2022, with completion expected late 2022.

Work on the Main Road and Russell Street, Main Road/Belair Road and Sheoak Road, and Sheoak Road and Russell Street junctions is planned to start mid-2022, with completion expected mid-2023.

Consultation on the proposed upgrade options for Shepherds Hill Road, Brighton Parade and Waite Street Intersection closed on 16 December 2021. All feedback received from the community is currently being reviewed by the project team.
