

Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road Intersection Upgrade

Main Avenue and Chessington Avenue temporary closure and nightworks

The Australian and South Australian Governments have jointly funded (50:50) \$35 million to upgrade the Glen Osmond Road and Fullarton Road intersection. Once complete, the upgrade will improve travel times and road safety, increase intersection capacity and enhance network reliability.

As part of this project, drainage and sewer main installation works are required to be undertaken on Main Avenue between Chessington Avenue and Avenue Road, Frewville.

What to expect

To minimise the impact to road users, **these works will be undertaken at night**. Works are scheduled to commence on **Tuesday, 1 November 2022 and are expected to be completed the morning of Saturday, 12 November 2022, weather permitting**. Hours of work are between 7pm and 6am. No works will be undertaken on Friday and Saturday nights.

To safely facilitate these works, **Chessington Avenue and Main Avenue will be closed to general traffic during night works. The project team will contact surrounding residents in person to provide further details on parking and access arrangements during these works. Emergency access will be facilitated as required.** Access to Frewville Foodland will be via Glen Osmond Road only.

All other motorists will be required to detour via Glen Osmond Road, Frederick Street and Avenue Road. Refer to the map overleaf for details. Please follow local detour signage and traffic controller instructions. Some noise disturbances can be expected at times while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents as much as practically possible. Access to properties will be maintained and every effort will be made to minimise impacts to surrounding properties and road users, as much as practically possible.

Please plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to take care when travelling through the area. For safety reasons there may be some restricted access. Where required, signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to alternative access and/or detours.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation whilst these important works are undertaken.
